PROJECT UPDATE

Perth Park | Sunday dewatering activities

We would like to inform you of some minor activities on Sundays required to enable site dewatering.

From Sunday 23 August until end-October 2026, limited site activities will be undertaken on Sundays between 9:00am and 5:00pm to facilitate essential site dewatering operations. Dewatering is the process of temporarily lowering and managing groundwater so that construction work can be safely completed below the natural groundwater level.

These works will be limited to:

- Water carts operating intermittently within the site to distribute treated water, and
- Trucks periodically collecting and transporting treated water from the site to approved wastewater disposal sites.

Due to the sites ground conditions a significant amount of dewatering is required across the project to maintain safe and workable site conditions, manage ongoing groundwater inflows and protect temporary works and surrounding infrastructure.

As these activities are minor in nature, we do not expect them to cause excessive noise or disruption. All activities will be undertaken in accordance with the project's approvals, relevant environmental controls, and applicable regulatory requirements. Noise and vibration monitoring will be conducted, where required, to verify compliance and ensure impacts remain within permitted limits.

We appreciate that construction-related activity on a Sunday may be noticeable to nearby residents. To minimise potential disruption, the project team will:

- Restrict activities to the hours of 9:00am to 5:00pm.
- Use the quietest practicable equipment available.
- Minimise work in areas closest to residential properties wherever reasonably practicable.
- Vibration and noise monitoring in line with the project's management plans.

We thank you for your patience and understanding while these essential site management activities are undertaken.
