Thank you for your email regarding works taking place on the Perth Park site on Saturdays.

We apologise for not communicating the change to working hours since the last project update.

Due to the site establishment program, work hours are now between Monday to Saturday. This is in line with guidelines outlined on the Town of Victoria Park [website](#) which states:

Builders and contractors must ensure all constructions site noise complies with the [Environmental Protection \(Noise\) Regulations 1997](#).

Construction noise is exempt (i.e. does not have to comply) with the assigned noise levels in the regulations if the work is conducted between the hours of 7am-7pm Monday to Saturday.

Updated information regarding working hours will be made available on our website shortly but will continue to align to these guidelines.

We apologise again for any inconvenience this may have caused and remain committed to keeping the community informed throughout the development of Perth Park.
